



MINUTES OF STUDY COURSE'S COUNCIL
12th February 2026

1. Announcements by the President

The President informs the Council about the following:

Prof. Simona Magi informs the Council that some students have not complied with the prescribed sequence for taking PTA examinations. For this reason, the President highlights again the PTA regulation (<https://www.medicina.univpm.it/?q=ptas-regulation>): “Students can enroll in PTA exams only if they have already passed the PTA exam of the previous year.” The AFP examinations must also be taken according to the sequential order of academic years.

2. Educational Offer

The President informs the Council about the educational offer for the A.Y. 2026-2027, confirming that the course will maintain its current format, which includes:

- An integrated curriculum with Biomedical Engineering
- The possibility of recognition of the Bachelor’s Degree in Biomedical Engineering
- Full delivery in English

The President also provides an update on the Rector’s Strategic Guidelines, emphasising the importance of strengthening English-taught programmes and aligning Study Courses with objectives consistent with regional, national, European, and international policies, with particular reference to artificial intelligence—resolved to maintain, for the next academic year, the same curricular structure, also in line with the objectives set out in the new 2026–2028 Strategic Plan.

“...Enhancing the attractiveness of Degree Programmes by ensuring better alignment with current labour market needs and ongoing transformations, in particular through:

Strengthening programmes delivered in English;

Developing Degree Programmes whose objectives are consistent with regional, national, European and international policies, such as: green and digital transition, with particular reference to artificial intelligence; climate change; security; sustainable development...”
