Important:

- For the Degree course in Medicina e Chirurgia (Italian language) the standard lectures of every course of the V and VI year take place during the first semester. Therefore, it will not be possible to obtain the CFU (ECTS) of those teachings for those students interested in attending only the second semester.
- For the Degree course in Dental Surgery and Prosthetic Dentistry the standard lectures of every course, starting from the III year, is organized during both semesters. Therefore, those students interested in attending only the second semester will be required to catch-up on the missed lectures that took place during the first semester with didactic material made available by the Professors, in order to obtain the CFU (ECTS) for those activities.

If, along with standard lectures, you also want to attend practice activity you must specify on your request the departments you're interested in so as to put the correct traineeship codes in the LA.

Please note: before the beginning of the practice activity attendance we will book a visit with the competent doctor, at the visit you must bring the following documents:

1. Mantoux/Quantiferon test results (carried out in the last 6 months)
2. Antibody evaluation (IgG Search) for the following diseases: Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Chicken Pox, Hepatitis B, Whooping cough

If your vaccination book show you already had two doses of vaccine for Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Chicken Pox, three doses for Hepatitis B and if the vaccination against whooping cough (usually issued along the anti-tetanus) has been carried out in the last 10 years, it's not mandatory to carry out antibody evaluations. It will still be required to bring with you your vaccination book the day of the visit with the competent doctor.

It's suggested to arrive in Italy complete with all the required documents otherwise you will have to carry out the missing exams at the lab at your expenses. In this case you must urgently notify via e-mail at the address erasmus.medicina@univpm.it the names of the missing exams.

Upon arrival, after completing all the formalities with the **International Relations Office** you have to go to the Students' Secretariat of the Medicine and Surgery cultural area, with an appointment which can be booked by contacting erasmus.medicina@univpm.it, in order to receive useful information regarding the attendance and obtaining your personal ID badge necessary for practice activity.

ERASMUS TRAINEESHIP

Students interested in carrying out a period of traineeship attendance at the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery of Università Politecnica delle Marche have to forward their request at the following addresses: eramsus.incoming@univpm.it - erasmus.medicina@univpm.it

In your request you will have to specify:

- name and surname
- home university
- original course in your home university and year of the course
- which departments are you interested in visiting
- attendance period and duration of the traineeship

Once the positive outcome of the request has been expressed you must notify the date of arrival at least 20 days prior to your actual arrival. The email address to inform about your arrival is erasmus.medicina@univpm.it thus allowing the booking of the visit with the competent doctor.

The suitability judgement of this visit is mandatory to begin the Hospital attendance.

At the visit you must bring the following documents:

1. Mantoux/Quantiferon test results (carried out in the last 6 months)
2. Antibody evaluation (IgG Search) for the following diseases: Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Chicken Pox, Hepatitis B, Whooping cough

If your vaccination book show you already had two doses of vaccine for Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Chicken Pox, three doses for Hepatitis B and if the vaccination against whooping cough (usually issued along the anti-tetanus) has been carried out in the last 10 years, it's not mandatory to carry out antibody evaluations. It will still be required to bring with you your vaccination book (translated in Italian or in English) the day of the visit with the competent doctor.

It's suggested to arrive in Italy complete with all the required documents otherwise you will have to carry out the missing exams at the lab at your expenses. In this case you must urgently notify via e-mail at the address erasmus.medicina@univpm.it the names of the missing exams.

The date of the visit will be communicated to you via e-mail and only after obtaining the suitability judgement it will be possible to start attending.

After carrying out the visit with the competent doctor you have to go to the Students' Secretariat of the Medicine and Surgery cultural area, with an appointment which can be booked by contacting erasmus.medicina@univpm.it, in order to receive useful information regarding the attendance and obtaining your personal ID badge necessary for practice activity.
